STAGE DETAILS

- Proscenium opening: 40' x 22' 7"
- Plaster line to upstage wall: 27'
- Wing space: Stage right – 7' wide x 13' deep,
..... Stage left – 7' wide x 12' deep
- Loading door dimensions: 12' wide x 7'10" tall
- Orchestra pit dimensions: 34' wide x 3' x 6' deep (with fixed organ console)

AUDIO EQUIPMENT

- 12 channel sound board
- 3 mics (Shure 58)
- 4 mics (Shure 57)
- 3 hand held wireless mics (VocoPro 4800 4-channel)
- 1 over the ear wireless mic
- 1-12 channel snake with 100' cable
- 2 P.A. speakers with 2-15" woofers each and horn (ElectroVoice)
- 1-500 watt per channel amplifier
- 3 amplifiers (QSC MX 1500A)
- 6.1 channel receiver (Yamaha RX-V459)
- 5 speakers (Acoustic Audio)

For movie projection:

- 3 main speakers each with 2 - 15" woofers and a horn (ElectroVoice TL3512)
- 3 - 18" subwoofers (ElectroVoice)
- 3 Crossover/equalizers (ElectroVoice XEQ 504A)

- 35mm projector (Strong Simplex with Ultra80 lamphouse - platter system)

STAGE RIGGING

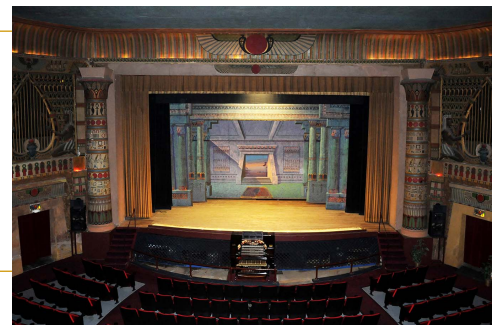
- Height from stage floor to underside of grid (wooden) 45'6"
- 16 linesets (Hemp rigging with gallery position stage right)
- Movie screen
- Blue/black back curtain
- Limited legs & border
- 4-6 historic back drops (limited use)

LIGHTING SYSTEM

- 4,000 watts of lights on each side of the balcony (4-channel multi-color)
- 3 travel spots (1 Chauvet 400G, 2-Strong Trouperette)
- 3,000 watts of down spots
- All lights are on an American DJ Scene Setter 48 channel dimmer panel

ADDITIONAL IMPROVEMENTS/AMENITIES

- Bus & truck parking just outside stage door
- 700 seat capacity (Including balcony)
- Disabled seating positions in several locations
- Original 1925 Wurlitzer organ
